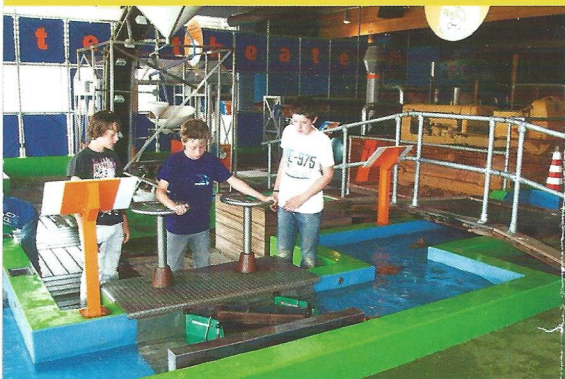


Discover the history of Flevoland
